Weeks 1- 4: Full-time English Studies

- 20 LPW = General English, Business English
- 5 LPW = Customer Service Option Class
- 2-hr = Job Readiness Workshop (one time)

Weeks 5 - 6: English Studies (am) + Job Interviews (pm)

- Morning English Studies (20 lessons per week)

Requirements:

- Minimum age: 19 years
- Minimum English level: GV 5 by start of work placement
- Completed application form, entrance exam and interview (phone/skype interview may also be required)
- English cover letter and resume
- Successful completion of min. 4 wks in General English + Customer Service Course
- 500 hrs of previous work experience
- Minimum 1 year of post secondary education (i.e. university, college, technical school or apprenticeship)
- **Students must have 1) a Canadian Study Permit & COOP Work Permit or 2) a Working Holiday Visa or 3) Young Worker Exchange Visa**
* must obtain Work Permit prior to arrival in Canada. Failure to do so will require change to WED Program or delay in work term start date.
